RAD

Royal Academy of Dance Instruction and Certification (Optional)

The RAD graded syllabi is available to our current and new students.

All Students signing up for the above classes receive the same excellent training but with the option of the RAD certification process.

- * All RAD students must register and attend both classes per week within their level for two terms.
- * RAD Students must maintain excellent and consistent attendance in order to qualify for and pass their examinations.
- * Exams are adjudicated by an RAD appointed instructor in technique, musicality and performance.
- * EXAMINATION FEES are set by the Royal Academy of Dance and are due at the start of Term 2.



In the interest of health and safety of our students and maintain standards set by the RAD, it is recommended and at the discretion of the instructor that a 2-year approach is taken to ensure the candidate is physically capable to meet the challenges and rigour of the RAD syllabus.

Fee Payment and Policies

Quinte Ballet School of Canada is a non-profit charitable organization. We offer excellence in training while keeping our fees affordable and competitive.

ALL REQUIRED FEES ARE DUE AT REGISTRATION AND INCLUDE APPROPRIATE TAXES

REGISTRATION FEE

Non-refundable annual \$30 fee OR \$50 fee if using the payment plan option. Fee covers all family members for both terms. Due upon registration.

ALL REQUIRED FEES ARE DUE AT REGISTRATION

DISCOUNTS (not applicable on registration fee)

Multiple Classes: Individual students receive a 10% discount if enrolling in three or more classes.

- OR -

Family Discount: Multiple family members enrolling in 4 or more combined classes receive 10% off base total.

Pay Now: A 5% discount will be applied if both Term 1 and Term 2 fees, including the performance fees, are paid at time of September registration.

ASSEMBLÉ 2019 PERFORMANCE FEES

Per student, due at Term 2 registration, covering all performance-related activities including costume creation/rental, theatre rental and all production related costs and student activities.

\$70 one class / \$40 each additional class.

Performance fees are non-refundable - all students participate in Assemblé 2019 as part of their training experience (Adult and weeDance classes exempted).

METHODS OF PAYMENT

Payments may be made by cash, cheque, E-transfer, debit or credit card (Visa or Mastercard).

NSF cheques are subject to a \$25 NSF fee.

REFUNDS AND CLASS EXCHANGES

Remaining classes within the current paid term (less applied discounts) are refunded, less the registration fee.

No refunds after 4 weeks of classes for both terms.

Class exchanges are not permitted after 3 weeks.

Class cancellations due to weather and are not refundable. Notification is made by Email and Facebook only.

Placement is determined at the Instructor's discretion and based on the student's age AND level of experience.

BALLET PROGRAM

Learn ballet vocabulary, emphasizing posture, alignment and technique, while developing expression, musicality and artistry. RAD optional.

POINTE

Develop an understanding of the art of pointe work. **Students must be enrolled in 2 senior level ballet classes (ballet 4 to 6) per week at the teacher's discretion.**

LYRICAL

A passionate and imaginative dance style merging ballet and jazz. Characterized by fluidity and grace.

JAZZ

Jazz dance technique focusing on rhythm, expression, movement and coordination. Pairs well with Ballet.

Jazz 1 45 minutes	ages 6 - 9yrs \$230 per Term
Jazz 2 60 minutes	ages 9 - 12yrs \$255 per Term
Jazz 3 (with experience) 60 minutes	ages 12yrs + \$255 per Term

HIP HOP

A popular and energetic class where students develop coordination and learn complex urban choreography. No previous experience is required.

Junior Hip Hop 60 minutes	ages 9 - 12yrs \$255 per Term
Senior Hip Hop 60 minutes	ages 12yrs + \$255 per Term

TAP

Develop your coordination, rhythm and musicality. 'Step-ball-change' in a fun and expressive art form that has evolved into a popular, contemporary dance genre.

Tap 3 (with experience) 60 minutes	ages 12yrs + \$255 per Term

ADDITIONAL DANCE PROGRAMS

weeDANCE

A fun and interactive class of play-acting, movement instruction, imagination and music in a studio setting.

ages 3 - 4yrs (must be 3yrs at time of registration)

JUNIOR DANCE

A pre-primary ballet level to explore dance through creative movement, music and rhythms.

JD1 ages 4 - 5yrs / JD2 ages 5 - 6yrs

Adult Ballet 1 60 minutes

A beginner level class with basic barre exercises for students with no previous ballet experience.

Adult Ballet 2 75 minutes

For those with 2 or more years of ballet experience.

Adult Modern 45 minutes

A contemporary class that enhances flexibility, fitness and strength. Uses more on-the-floor space, with movement that is expressive and creative.

***NEW* Resistance Barre** 45 minutes

Suitable for all levels of fitness/dance experience, and combining movements influenced by Ballet, Yoga and Pilates. Exercises focus on isometric strength training.

Adult Tap 45 minutes

A beginner to intermediate class that covers basic tap steps and combinations, with simple choreography.
